## **ESL Identification and Placement**

- If a student enters MMISD having never been in school before and their Home Language Survey says Spanish is the primary language in the home, MMISD is required by law to test that student.
  - They are given the Woodcock-Munoz test from the list of Approved Tests by TEA.
  - If the student scores at or below the 40th percentile on the test, the LPAC committee meets to place them in the ESL program.
  - If the student scores above the 40th percentile, the LPAC committee meets to determine the best placement of the student.
  - If the student is in Special Ed, the LPAC committee and the ARD committee work together to determine the best placement of the student.
  
- If a student enters MMISD from another school that has already placed them in ESL, that student automatically enters our ESL program.
